Born in Caracas, Venezuela, and based between New York City and Berlin, Germany, Arturo Herrera made his first impression on the Alamo City as an Artpace resident in 2000 and was showcased earlier this year with a solo exhibition at the Linda Pace Foundation. Widely recognized for collages that cast

a surreal haze over Disney iconography, Herrera works in a range of media including sculpture, painting and oddly compelling felt wall hangings with qualities some have likened to the drips and splatters of a Jackson Pollock. Similarly bold and graphic are Herrera's wall paintings, one of which will adorn Frost Bank's Parking Garage (viewable from Main Plaza) through 2016. Inspired by movement and "the dynamism of abstraction," Herrera's red-and-white Adam (the Linda Pace Foundation's first large-scale public installation) weighs in at 2,500 square feet.
