"ArtGuide: Must See", ArtForum, February 13, 2014

In the late 1960s Minimal music pioneer Steve Reich made a composition using sound bites from the taped testimony of six Harlem teenagers who were accused of murder and brutally beaten by the police. Borrowing Reich's title, Glenn Ligon's exhibition revisits the so-called "Harlem Six" with three monumental screen-print paintings that imbue the deceptively simple words "come out to show them" with a newfound urgency.
