Lone Wolf Recital Corps at Museum of Modern Art, New York

The exhibition titled “Projects 107: Lone Wolf Recital Corps” featuring the works of Terry Adkins and multidisciplinary performance collective is on view at Museum of Modern Art, New York.

The show reunites the Corps for the first time post the demise of founder Terry Adkins (American, 1953–2014). The selection of works on display features Adkins’ sculptures alongside 5 performances by the newly reconstituted Corps. These performances will be carried out by a changing group of multigenerational artists who will be showcasing new works and reprise works from the group’s collection. The sculptures on exhibit trace the history and evolution of the Corps. These include *Dark Night* (1987–88), *Upperville* (2009), and *Methane Sea* (2013). Apart from these “Projects 107: Lone Wolf Recital Corps” also features a new acquisition, *Last Trumpet* (1995), made of four 18-foot-long horns termed by Adkins as *Akrhaphones*. These horns serve as sculpture as well as functional instruments.

The Lone Wolf Recital Corps consists of rotating membership of collaborators from various musical and visual-arts disciplines. The Corps performed within and in conjunction with Terry Adkins’ exhibition till he was alive. These performances include spoken word, live music, video projection, and costumed, choreographed movement. Lone Wolf

Recital Corps performances have commemorated and celebrated well-known personalities such as abolitionist John Brown, jazz musician John Coltrane, explorer Matthew Henson, and blues singer Bessie Smith.

“Projects 107: Lone Wolf Recital Corps” runs from August 19 through October 9, 2017, at Museum of Modern Art, 11 W 53rd St, New York, NY 10019, USA.
